ASX RELEASE – CHANGE OF NAME OF THE TRADING COUNTER TO ASIAN AMERICAN MEDICAL GROUP LIMITED

The Company wishes to announce that following the special resolution passed at the Annual General Meeting on 5 December 2012 and the approval obtained yesterday from the Australian Securities and Investments Commission ("ASIC"), the name of the Company has been changed to **Asian American Medical Group Limited** ("AAMG") effective immediately.

The name change is in line with the announcement on 20 September 2012 by its wholly-owned subsidiary **Asian American Medical Group Inc.**, a registered company in the British Virgin Islands, following the formalisation of the partnership with The University of Pittsburgh Medical Center ("UPMC").

The Company has arranged with the Australian Securities Exchange Limited ("ASX") for the change of name of its trading counter on ASX to **Asian American Medical Group Limited** to take effect from 10:00 a.m. of 19 December 2012.

The name changes will not affect any of the business with our existing clients and the board believes it is in the interest of the company and its shareholders as a whole.

About Asian Centre for Liver Diseases and Transplantation

Asian American Medical Group ("AAMG"), formerly known as Asian Centre for Liver Diseases and Transplantation ("ACLDT"), was established in 1994 in Singapore. It is one of Asia's foremost Liver Centres with out-patient facilities as well as a dedicated in-patient Liver Ward and Intensive Care Unit to complement its highly successful Living Donor Liver Transplantation (LDLT) Programme.

With the collaboration with The University of Pittsburgh Medical Center ("UPMC"), AAMG will extend to offer quality treatment beyond liver-related diseases and transplantation including kidney, blood and bone marrow transplant programmes through Asia's first Comprehensive Transplant Centre (CTC).

AAMG is led by renowned hepatobiliary expert and liver transplant surgeon, Dr Tan Kai Chah (Dr K C Tan), who helped start the Liver Transplant Programme at the King's College Hospital London, the UK. Dr Tan performed many pioneering operations in the UK including the first 'split-liver' transplant, first auxiliary liver graft and completed a pilot study of living donor liver transplantation.

AAMG is the first private medical centre in South-east Asia to have performed more than 200 living donor liver transplants as at 30 November 2012. On average, ACLDT treats 8,000 patients a year, of which over 90% are international patients from South-east Asia, South Asia, Indochina, the Middle East and Russia.

AAMG was listed on the Australian Securities Exchange in September 2009 (ASX:AJJ).

It opened its first overseas liver centre in Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam, in September 2010.
